



## Chamber of Commerce and Industry Veszprém

The Chamber of Commerce and Industry Veszprém (CCIV) was established on 28th of October 1994. The organization works for the interests of micro, small and medium enterprises, companies and all economic actors in Veszprém County, Hungary, in order to boost innovation and economic development of our region.

### >> Legal background

According to the law accepted by the Parliament of the Hungarian Republic in 1994, the chambers of commerce and industry operate as public bodies in Hungary. Their basic tasks are promoting the development and competitiveness of enterprises, managing vocational education, protecting and representing interests of SMEs.

### >> Operation

In Hungary the chambers of commerce and industry compose a national network which has local organizations with legal personality in each county. The chambers have extensive professional relations which are really advantageous for the small and medium enterprises and companies. The Chamber of Veszprém has about 1000 members from the industrial, commerce, touristic and handicraft sectors of Veszprém County, they give approximately 70% of the revenue of the region. The membership is voluntarily since 2000, but the registration of companies is compulsory since 2011.

CCIV's activities focus on the economic development, the fair business behaviour, the intermediate vocational education & training and the protection of the interests of SMEs and companies.
